#### **A Resolution to Increase Hand Sanitizer Dispensers Within Dining Halls**

WHEREAS, on-campus dining restaurants only have hand sanitizer dispensers at the entrance; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of dining rush periods many dining guests bypass these hand sanitizer dispensers; and,

WHEREAS, In a survey of freshman (most frequent dining restaurant visitors), 73.3% reported not using these dispensers or being aware of their presence; and,

WHEREAS, germs spread quickly through hand to hand or hand to food contact both which can contaminate the serving utensils and ultimately other individuals (Minnesota Department of Health); and,

WHEREAS, dining visitors are permitted to serve themselves, eat, and return for additional servings without having an accessible way to use to hand sanitizer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the 30<sup>th</sup> Administration of the Student Government Association, on behalf of the student body, would like to thank the University of Georgia Dining Services for adding more hand sanitizer dispensers and placing them in more accessible locations throughout the dining restaurants; and,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association will continue to work with dining services and commit to working with dining restaurant managers to continuously identify convenient and accessible positions for hand sanitizer dispensers; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, The University of Georgia Dining Services Executive Director, Bryan Varin, and Associate Director of Meal Plan Operations, Danielle Bouton, has given support for this project and will oversee the implementation within each dining restaurant.
