*During the 2020 SGA General Election, 10,416 students voted to elect the executive officers and senators of the 33<sup>rd</sup> Administration. The voting period started Monday, February 24, 2020, at 8 a.m. and continued through Wednesday, February 26, 2020, at 12 p.m. (noon).*

*During the 2020 SGA Runoff Election, 11,324 students voted to elect the executive officers and Senator of the School of the Public and International Affairs of the 33<sup>rd</sup> Administration. The voting period started Thursday, February 27, 2020, at 8 a.m. and continued through Friday, February 28, 2020, at 12 p.m. (noon).*
