NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the 30th Administration of the Student Government Association, on behalf of the student body, will partner with the Tate Student Center and Center

for Student Activities and Involvement to execute and expand the Transfer Student Welcome of 2018.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Student Government Association seeks to establish a Spring Welcome event, which aims to emulate UGA's Fall Freshman Welcome Program by including Spring first-year students, in addition to transfer students.

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the 30th Administration of the Student Government Association, in partnership with the Center for Student Activities and Involvement and Tate Student Center, will establish and plan an annual Spring Welcome event beginning in spring of 2019.
