2022 SGA General Election Results

During the 2022 SGA General Election, 2482 students voted to elect the executive officers and senators of the 35th Administration of the University of Georgia. In addition, a constitutional ratification was on the ballot for approval by the student body. The voting period started Monday, February 21, 2022, at 8 a.m. and continued through Wednesday, February 23, 2022, at 12 p.m. (noon). The official elections results follow.

Constitution Ratification

Every four years, SGA reviews its current constitution to evaluate its effectiveness and accuracy via a Constitutional Revision Commission. The Commission drafted proposed changes which received an affirmative two-thirds vote by the SGA Senate to be added to the ballot. The newly proposed Constitution shall be ratified (approved) by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of at least 10% of the student body.

The newly proposed constitution is not ratified. The required threshold of ten percent of the student body did not vote on the ballot measure.
